A process can contain one to many threads



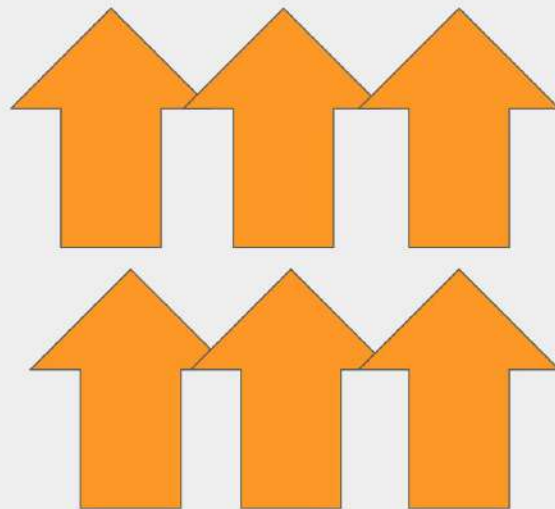

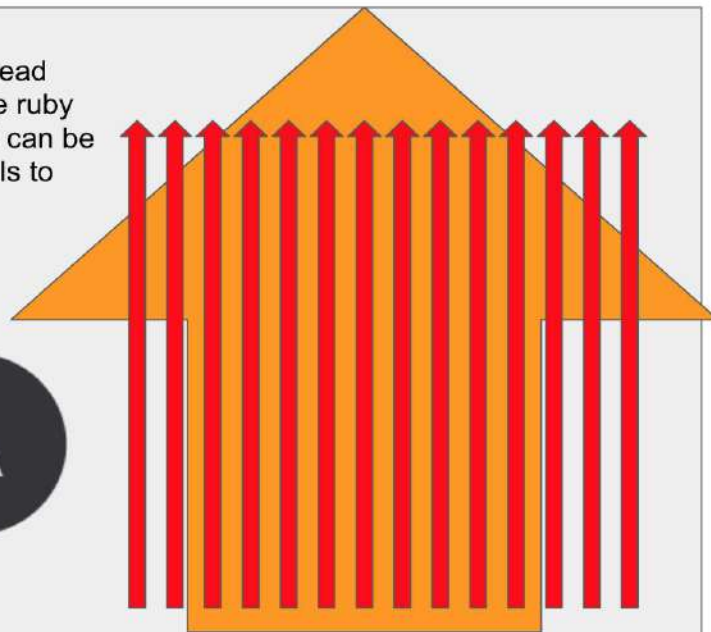
6 Big Process, each of which can only handle one request at a time. If a request needs to make a http call or talk to the db, the whole process must wait

Puma

One big process, up to 16 threads. Each thread can represent a request. It can only execute ruby code in one thread at once, but each thread can be waiting on things like http requests or db calls to finish without blocking the process.

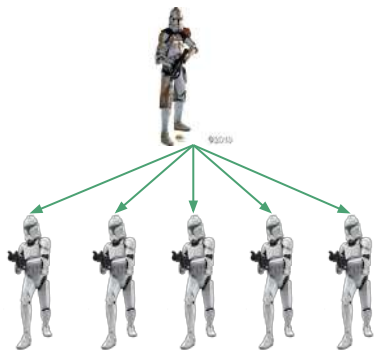
The BEAM



#CodeBEAMSF

BEAM processes fail independently of each other

- A process failing will not bring down a node, or affect other processes
- A process can use a VM primitive called a monitor, which means that it will receive a message if another process dies. This can be used for error recovery
- Beam applications organize their processes into a hierarchical structure called a "supervision" tree, where "parents" are responsible for listening to messages that their child failed and restarting them

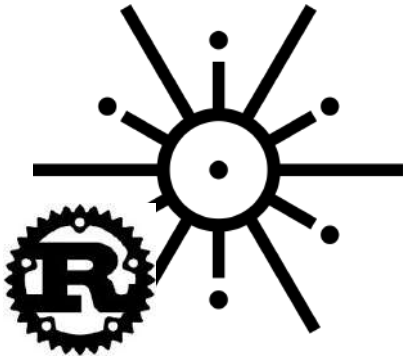

#CodeBEAMSF

The BEAM is not great for every problem

- Not great at number crunching
- Not statically typed (some people view this as a plus)
- Not as fast as Go on individual computations
- Smaller community than other languages

Elixir/Erlang are NOT Object Oriented

There are no:

- Classes
- Instances of Classes
- Sub Classes
- Mutable State
